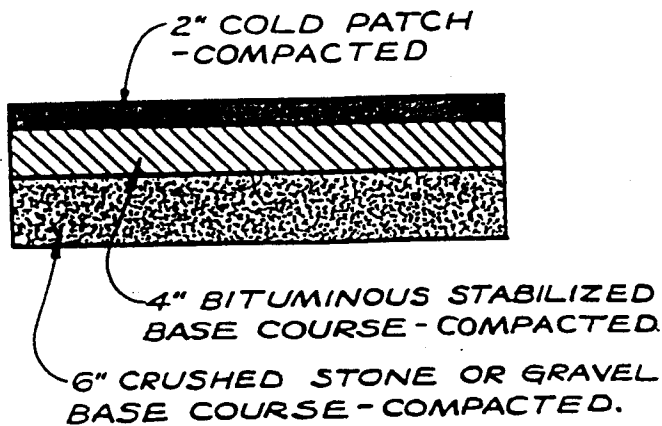

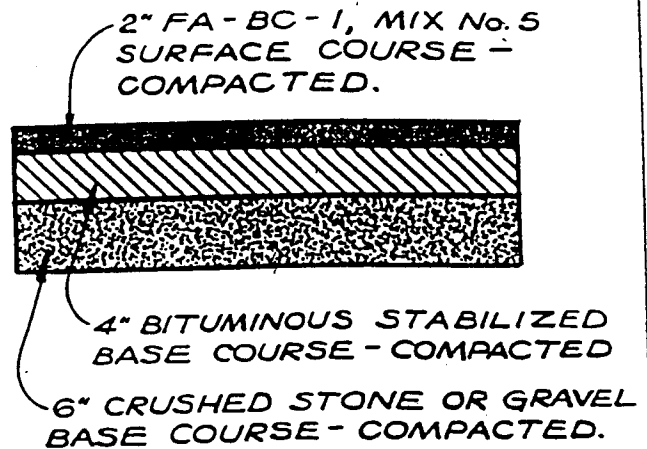
# MEDFORD TOWNSHIP:- STREET OPENING RESTORATION DETAILS

## INITIAL REPAIR



1. EDGES TO BE CUT WITH A SHARP TOOL TO NEAT, STRAIGHT VERTICAL LINES.
2. BACKFILL MATERIAL TO BE DRY, CLEAN, WELL-GRADED GRANULAR MATERIAL COMPACTED IN 6" LIFTS.

## FINAL REPAIR



1. THE 2" OF COLD PATCH TO BE REMOVED, EDGES TACKED, AND 2" FA-BC-1, MIX No. 5 SURFACE COURSE APPLIED, ROLLED OR MECHANICALLY TAMPED TO A SMOOTH, TIGHT EVEN SURFACE.

1. Street Opening Application is to be procured from the Township Clerk's office, filled out and returned to the Clerk's office.
2. The application is to be appraised by the Township Engineer and deposit and fee calculated by the Township Engineer.
3. Fee and deposit is to be paid to the Township Clerk, after notification to the applicant by the clerk.
4. Street opening shall be opened and preliminarily restored as expeditiously as possible not to exceed 10 days. Opening and restorations must be accomplished within 8 hours.
5. The initial repair is to remain for a period of settlement of 30 days. (In the cases of unavailability of hot-mixed asphalt (example: winter months or special cases), longer periods of settlement may be required, during which time the applicant will maintain the road repair with suitable materials i.e. coldpatch, quarry blend etc.) to Township standards.
6. After the 30 day settlement period the final repair is to be made according to the township standards.
7. The applicant is to notify the Township Clerk's office after the final repair is made, giving location of the repair, name, address, and phone number. The final repair is then inspected by the Township Engineer and if acceptable, 50% of the applicant's deposit is returned through the Township Clerk's office. If the repair does not meet the Township standards it is to be re-repaired to Township standards, and the Clerk's office notified for another inspection by the Township Engineer.
8. After a period of 6 months from the date of acceptance of the final repair, the applicant is to notify the Township Clerk's office for a final inspection of the road repair and acceptance by the Township, the remainder of the applicant's deposit is returned through the Township Clerk's Office. In cases where the road repair has failed to meet the Township standards during this 6 month period, it shall be re-repaired and another 6 month maintenance period shall apply.
