Free State Park Admission All Summer Long!

Entry to all NJ State Parks, forests, & recreation areas is free of charge this summer. Park entrance fees will be waived for all visitors, regardless of residency. Anyone who already purchased a 2022 annual State Park pass will automatically receive a full refund.

Jackson Road Bridge Update

Per Burlington County, the work on the Jackson Road Bridge will commence on or before August 1, 2022. Burlington County will make advanced notification to the Township of the work start date. The work is anticipated to be completed by the end of the year.

Tax Bills

At this time, the Township has not received the final 2022 Tax Rate from Burlington County in order to print and mail the 2022/2023 Tax Bills. If needed, an extended grace period will be provided and noted on the tax bills.

Fort Medford Project in Bob Meyer Park



The improvements at Fort Medford in Bob Meyer Park have been completed; and the playground has been officially re-opened.

There is still some painting to do on the new wood components, and this will take place next Spring after the wood has had a chance to weather.

There are several new pieces of play equipment, so the Township encourages everyone to enjoy the new improvements; made possible through capital budget funds allocated by the Township Council and grant funds received from the Burlington County Municipal Park Development Grant Program.

Leaf Removal from Jackson Road & Eton Lane Open Space

The leaf piles from the 2021 leaf collection that were temporarily stored at the Jackson Road and Eton Lane open space have been removed. The ruts at Eton Lane will be filled in and grass seed will be applied.
