Food Truck Events:

The first food truck event along Main Street was held on August 16, 2018 and was an overwhelming success. So much so that the Council has expanded the number of food trucks and more seating areas and restrooms will be added! The next food truck event will be Thursday, September 20th and will continue to occur monthly through December on the 3rd Thursday of the month. Road Improvement Program:

The 2017 Phase II Road Improvement Program is underway. A portion of Jackson Road has been paved and the contractor just completed the paving of Mill Street. Iron Rock Lane is scheduled for work to begin on or about September 4, 2018. The contractor plans to proceed to the following roads after September 4th: Indian Spring Lane, Greenbriar Lane, Pine Valley Drive, Saxony & Sherwood Courts, Pin Oak Trail, Normandy Drive, Normandy Court, Woodthrush Trail East and West, Olde Mill Court and guide rail installation at Pontiac Drive and Shanty Dam Drive.

The Skeet Road Phase II & Phase III bids have been received and opened and a Resolution to award the contract is scheduled to be considered by Council at the September 4, 2018 Council Meeting. Work is anticipated to begin sometime in November. The October newsletter will have more information.
